

Brassies Summer Meeting Minutes

June 18, 2025, held at Ocala Golf Club

Meeting called to order by Robin Cunningham, President at 10:00 AM

Members in attendance: Terry Hrobuchak, Carol Smith, Janice Villa, Kathy Quelland, JoAnn Brady, Jan Frame, Terry Delcamp, Robin Cunningham, Joy Benson, Rose Pinard, Jackie Dzieken, Pat Kordalski

1. Verification of Officers: all existing officers except Secretary will remain as is for the 2025-2026 Brassies year.
2. Minutes of the June 2024 meeting were read and verified. Motion to accept by Jo Ann Brady and seconded by Rose Pinard. Motion passed
3. Treasurer's report submitted. Current Balance is \$6,794.44.
Beginning balance on May 30, 2024 was \$5,314.44
Balance at end of golf year on May 30, 2025 was \$5,675.44
 - a. Jan Frame noted that the website was renewed until June 2028 at a cost of \$48
 - b. A discussion was held about raising the amount paid out for each tournament since the balance of dollars is so high.
Motion: a third of the field will be paid for each team event (increased from a fourth) and an increase of \$5 per place paid will be made for each individual event.
Motion made by Kathy Quelland and seconded by Janice Villa. Motion passed unanimously.
 - c. A motion was made by Janice and seconded by Terry to accept the Treasurer's report. Passed unanimously,
4. The tournament schedule is being made. Janice Villa reported that we have fewer clubs now than in year's past so some clubs have to host 2 years or more in a row. There are currently 11 Brassies clubs. She will look at scheduling clubs such as Continental, Royal Oaks, Country Club of Ocala and Broadstripes even though there is no delegate assigned to these clubs. A request was made for 9:00 or later shotgun starts to accommodate those who have to travel a long way. A discussion to possibly schedule Trilogy/Ocala Preserve was held but it was decided not to schedule them because they are not an 18 hole course.
5. Membership report: Currently there are 98 paid members which is down from 117 members last year.

Old Business:

1. Lunch options at Tournaments: the consensus is that having lunch as an optional choice worked well at all tournaments and will continue

2. Pace of play improved with grouping format (AACC, BBDD): the consensus was that this format seems to work well. A suggestion was made, however, to ask the ranger at each course to strongly enforce pace of play if a group was 1 or more holes behind.

New Business:

1. Discussion to increase the max index for membership from the current max index of 20.4: a vigorous discussion was had about increasing the max index for Brassies to 23.0 for membership.
Motion: for the 2026 Brassies year, the maximum handicap index shall be 23.0.
For new membership, this index must be demonstrated for two months as specified in current bylaws.
Motion made by Janice Villa and Seconded by Jo Ann Brady
Motion passed
2. Dee Reynolds and Elaine Mielke who passed away during the 2024-25 year will be recognized for their long contributions to Brassies in the annual yearbook and on the website.
3. A discussion about adding a Pro Lady to the tournament schedule was had. It was discussed that there are not that many pros to play, each lady might not play with their pro and the pro prize money would not be much. The discussion was tabled.
4. A discussion about adding a Guest day was had but it was tabled for now.
5. Player of the Year for 2024-25 is Kathy Quelland. Jackie Dziekan clarified that a member must play in a minimum of 5 individual tournaments during the year in order to be eligible.
6. Perfect Attendance was Jackie Dziekan and Susan Ishii.
7. Jan noted she will be out of town July 5-25 and August 2-20 but she will process new membership applications as she can.
8. Terry asked each delegate to carefully check member information submitted for correct spellings, phone numbers and email addressed
